MINUTES OF THE ORDER

1. Pursuant to our order dated 8th February, 1997 the representatives of the Petitioners and Respondents held a joint inspection of Ganesh Khind Road and in particular the stretch of the road between ICS Colony and Range Hill Road.

2. The Petitioners state that considerable work for road & road widening has already been undertaken and most of the big trees have been cut or are about to cut. The Respondents state that they shall transplant total 40 trees which are along this stretch of Ganesh khind Road which are identified during the joint

inspection. In case the transplantation is not successful, the respondents will plant the trees twice the number of such trees, As per the plan 10 trees are to be cut.

4. The respondents will display one month in advance on the notice board of the road department the list of major roads that are proposed to be widened (in that ~~official~~ year.)

5. The respondents are ready to nominate one person from all the environmental groups as a member of Tree Authority as per Sec.3(3) of Act in compliance with this Hon'ble Court's order dt.22-3-1993 in writ Petition No.2124/93 and dated 6-1-1994 in W.P. 5110/93.

6. Petition disposed off in the above terms.
