Programs Conducted during the FY 2012-13:

- **4th August 2012:** At Patrakar Bhavan Pune: Seminar on 'Let us manage Pune's 'Garbage' before it is too late'
- **16 August 2012:** A member of NCM gave B. G. Deshmukh lecture on "RTI Act a facilitator for citizens to participate in governance"
- **8th October 2012:** President, Nagrik Chetna Manch was the moderator for the One Day Regional workshop on the theme "Proactive Disclosure and notification of RTI Rules by Appropriate Governments and Competent Authorities" organized by Yashwantrao Chavan Academy of Development Administration (YASHADA)
- **20th March 2013:** At Poona Club: Interaction with Commissioner of Police, Pune, Shri Gulabrao Pol.

Major Achievements:

1. Amended the PIL 73 of 2010 regarding flyovers to include the 2-tier flyover being constructed at the CoEP traffic junction. It will be important to note that Alumni Association of College of Engineering Pune had approached Nagrik Chetna Manch to take up with the Bombay High Court for a stay on the 2-tier flyover comprising of three flyovers at the CoEP traffic junction. Alumni Association of College of Engineering Pune, has also given a donation of Rs. 50,000/- to NCM for the purpose.
2. A member of NCM was part of the four member team that assessed the alleged contempt involved in PIL 41 of 2011 filed by Jalbiradari and Baner Area Sabha against PMC. The report was submitted to the Bombay High Court. Hearings have not taken place.
3. NCM withdrew from membership of the Steering Committee for the preparation of Development Plan 2007 because we found that the proceedings were a whitewash with all constructive suggestions from NGOs being rejected without discussion or assigning any reasons.

4. NCM was in the forefront along with Surajya Sangharsh Samiti in protesting against the confidentiality maintained by PMC by not disclosing in full the draft DP-2013.
5. NCM submitted a 11-page document giving "Suggestions & Objections" on draft DP-2013 and recommended, "In view of the serious irregularities; lack of transparency and violation of existing norms, guidelines, industry practices and the prevalent laws in the preparation of the draft DP and the corresponding DC Rules as brought out in the Suggestions & Objections, which smack of clear extraneous pressure on the Commissioner and others who are involved in the making of the draft DP, **Nagrik Chetna Manch** strongly recommends scrapping of this draft DP and nominating an outside agency to do the same."
6. NCM submitted a 6-page report giving suggestions and objections on the draft City Development Plan 2041, which was under preparation by Voyants Solutions Pvt. Ltd, New Delhi.
7. Marathi daily 'Sakal' organised a 'Bus Day' on 1 November 2012. NCM was part of the Committee formed to give inputs to Sakal Newspapers. NCM then prepared a paper on "Lessons Learnt and Re-learnt", which helped in preparing an action plan for PMPML.
8. NCM undertook a detailed study of the Waste to Energy Plant set up by Rochem Separation Systems Pvt Ltd at Survey No. 86, Ram Tekdi Industrial Area, Hadapsar. Adjoining it is a MSW Processing Plant run by Disha Waste Management Pvt Ltd at Survey No. 87, which makes vermicompost. We carried out two visits to the site and have sent a letter giving details of violation of environmental laws, such as EP Act, Air Act, Water Act, MSW (Mgt & Handling) Rules etc to PMC, MPCB and CPCB. We are awaiting a response. In sum:
 - a. Both plants do not have consent under the Air & Water Acts,
 - b. Both plants are polluting the atmosphere and ground water. However, PMC/MPCB do not even take readings of tests on ambient air, ground water and for bad smell.
 - c. At least one foreign company, which had in its possession land near these plants has abandoned the idea of expanding its business in Hadapsar.
 - d. Rochem Plant technology appears to be in trouble because it has not yet generated electricity on a continuing basis while the project was to be completed by 23 May 2012. It is already delayed by 494 days. In fact, we have evidence to show that there has been an industrial accident in the Plant.
 - e. PMC has suffered a loss of over ₹. 4.35 Crores by now and continues to suffer about ₹. 90000/- per day in terms of penalty that is not being charged to Rochem.
 - f. We have recommended immediate corrective actions and stopping of both these projects until they take corrective measures.
